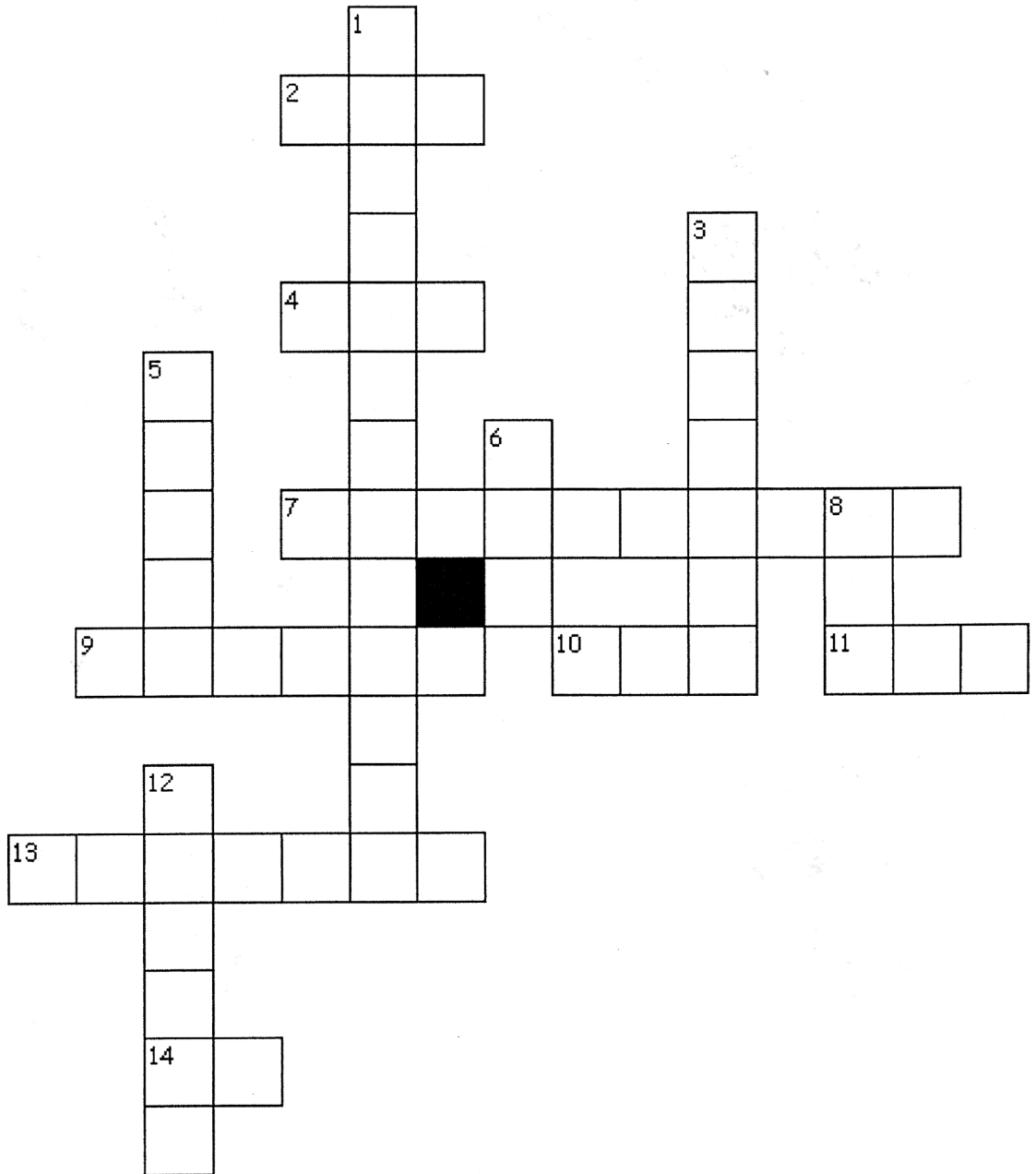


SIP Course Crossword Puzzle
